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### Brightspace tools for assessment and feedback

Brightspace, the university's virtual learning environment, has many built-in tools to support assessment and feedback practice. To help you make the most of these tools the EDU has produced a variety of **illustrated guides**:

• Assignments, feedback and grades

This resource offers an introduction to the Brightspace Assignments tool, including setting up, using Turnitin, rubrics and the Grades tool.

Brightspace quiz tool

This resource introduces the quiz tool, including where to find it and instructions on how to set up a new quiz. The following are two associated guides:

- Previewing quizzes
- Question library vs. Question pool

Brightspace can also be used to set up assignments designed for groups, not just individuals:

- Supporting Learning Online




#### **LinkedIn Learning**
